





IMPACT STORIES FROM FELLOWS

Philips Olushola Afolayan

Lagos State Model Senior College,
Agbowa-Ikosi, Epe, Lagos state.



At Philip's placement school, he observed that a minimum of 20 students report to the sickbay weekly for varying health issues. Overpopulation, inadequate health infrastructure, malnutrition, lack of exercise, and poor hygiene contribute to prevalence of preventable illnesses. Additionally, boarding school life intensifies exposure to communicable diseases due to overcrowding.

Aiming to enhance students' health and hygiene, he utilizes Adolescent Health Initiative as a club to educate students on personal and environmental hygiene, reproductive health, nutrition, exercise,

emotional health and disease prevention. Through weekly club meetings and health seminars involving qualified health personnel, he also trained students to become health educators who will drive change in their school and society.

Since the commencement of this initiative, the outcomes and impact recorded include: Optimal physical, mental and emotional health among students, increased access to quality health education, about 50 students have been trained to become first aiders, the students have reported an increase in their emotional health, self-esteem and self-confidence.



Philip Afolayan, a Teach For Nigeria Fellow, mentored three students from Lagos State Model Senior College in Agbowo, Epe, to win the first prize of 100,000 naira at a Robotics Competition. He also led his students to qualify for the State of the 774 Young Nigerian Scientists Presidential Award Competition.



Through our partnership with the Lagos State Government in 2020, we have placed a total of 276 fellows in 209 schools, who have impacted 590 students. A total of 12 social impact projects can be implemented. The Change (BTC) projects have been implemented.




